SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS PLANNING TO MAJOR IN AN ARTS RELATED PROGRAM

The Ennis Public Theater Scholarship will be awarded to the high school senior(s) who best meet the requirements described herein and set forth by the Scholarship Committee for the Ennis Public Theater ("Committee"). Award amounts are at the discretion of the Committee and the Board of Directors of the Ennis Public Theater ("Board").

The Committee will review all submitted applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone. The Committee may choose to interview applicants. The scholarship recipients will be notified in writing by May 1, 2020.

An Arts Related program would include: *Architecture, Sculpture, Painting, Literature, Music, Performing Arts, Film, Fine Arts and Teaching in any Art's Related Areas.*

Guidelines for the Ennis Public Theatre Scholarship Program

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors from the Ennis, Texas area. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name.

Student applicants must meet the following guidelines:

1. Plan to attend an accredited college or university on a full time basis.***
2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the college of his/her choice for the fall semester of 2019.

***Must intend to enroll in a course of study that is an Arts Related Program.

Student applicant may note any special financial needs on their application form. A personal essay from an Applicant will be included as well as any recommendations (not to exceed 2).

All applications and supporting documents must be received no later than April 1, 2020.

Please advise your high school/college registrar of this deadline for submission of transcripts and other supporting documentation.
