DIRECTOR'S NOTES

We remember *The Sound of Music* for classic songs like "My Favorite Things" and "Do-Re-Mi." It's a beautiful love story about Captain von Trapp and Maria and the difficult decisions they make in order to be together. But it's also a love story about a country on the verge of losing itself and the difficult decisions each character has to make about who they want to be in the new world order.

The Sound of Music is set in the late 1930s on the eve of Anschluss, the take over of Austria by Nazi Germany. The adults and soon-to-be- adults (like Liesl and Rolf) are forced to reckon with the loss of their country. Some of them are optimistic that they can remain neutral, some join the other side, and some refuse to acquiesce. Friends and neighbors find themselves on opposing sides.

Rodgers and Hammerstein wove together a funny, romantic, heart-breaking, and cautionary tale based on the real life memoir of Maria von Trapp.

Our rehearsal process for this show has been unconventional, to say the least. Through the chaos of our times, this cast has been a dream to work with. They have been patient, flexible, hard-working and supportive of one another.






