

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

What is real? How do we define sanity in a world where people believe in opposite versions of the truth? How can we possibly live peacefully with those who don't share our version of reality?

John Patrick asked his audiences these same questions in 1950. The Curious Savage premiered 74 years ago but, as with many great theatrical works, the messages of this show still apply.

Mrs. Ethel Savage has been sent to The Cloisters (a home for mental patients) by her step-children. They claim that the way Ethel is spending their late father's money proves she's not stable - her blue hair and penchant for carrying a teddy bear further prove their case. But, if Mrs. Savage comes to her senses and tells her step-kids where she's hidden \$10 million in bonds, they'll be happy to end her confinement.

The doctor and nurse of The Cloisters don't know what to make of Mrs. Savage. She doesn't know what to make of them either— or her fellow residents.

Each patient Mrs. Savage now resides with lives in their own version of reality. Ethel is almost positive she's not insane. So how is it that she finds herself belonging more and more here in The Cloisters?

You may notice that the walls of this set are not solid. The room on stage is a frame representing different frames of mind. The walls between reality and fantasy are left to your imagination. It's hard to know where the sanity begins and the insanity ends?

We loved this play from the moment we started reading the script. Many poignant thoughts about life and love mix with humor to help us laugh as we ponder the complexities of a quality life.

Our goal is to give dignity and depth to the characters who live in The Cloisters. They are, in many ways, the heroes of the story. They know how to love. They practice radical compassion and acceptance. These characters who have been labeled by the outside world as thinking wrong, have an awful lot to teach us about living right.

We would like to thank this hard working cast and crew for putting in the hours of work to make this happen. It has been a pleasure working with them. We think you will find them to be compelling storytellers.




